In Christ, I am:

Dearly loved	'Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience' (Col 3:12)
A child of God	'See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!' (1 Jn 3:1a)
A new creation	'Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!' (2 Cor 5:17)
God's masterpiece	'For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.' (Eph 2:10)
Forgiven	'[God] forgave us all our sins, having cancelled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.' (Col 3:13b-14)
Not condemned	'Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus...Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. Who then is the one who condemns? No one.' (Rom 8:1, 33-34a)
Redeemed	'Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole."' (Gal 3:13)
Reconciled	'[God] reconciled us to himself through Christ' (2 Cor 5:18)
Justified	'Since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ' (Rom 5:1)
Chosen	'[God] chose us in [Christ] before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.' (Eph 1:4)
Accepted	'Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.' (Rom 15:7)
Righteous	'But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe' (Rom 3:21-22a)

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Holy	'To all...who are loved by God and called to be his holy people: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ.' (Rom 1:7)
Without blemish	'[God] has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation' (Col 1:22)
Secure	'My sheep listen to my [Jesus'] voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.' (Jn 10:27-29)
Free	'So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.' (Jn 8:36)
Valuable	'For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.' (1 Pet 1:18-19)
A temple of God's Spirit	'Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?' (1 Cor 6:19a)
An heir of God	'So you are no longer a slave, but God's child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.' (Gal 4:7)
Seated with Christ	'And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.' (Eph 2:6-7)
Part of a royal nation and holy priesthood	'But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.' (1 Pet 2:9)
